KATANNING WELCOME PRECINCT & ALL AGES PLAYGROUND

Name of the project: Katanning Welcome Precinct

Name of the client: Shire of Katanning

The Katanning Welcome Precinct is envisioned by the Shire of Katanning as a major recreational resident and tourist hub servicing the heart of the great southern region, and will represent a premier community gathering and recreational space within the Shire.

The current All Ages Playground within the precinct is a heritage site and was established by local farmers over 30 years ago. It forms a key facility within the precinct. PLAN E was commissioned to prepare a Master Plan for the Welcome Precinct integrating the all ages playground, and undertake design, documentation and contract administration of the playground to restore existing features to current Australian Standards and introduce new and unique dynamic play elements in keeping with the existing design style and philosophy of the playground. Construction of the new \$5M facility was completed in December 2020.

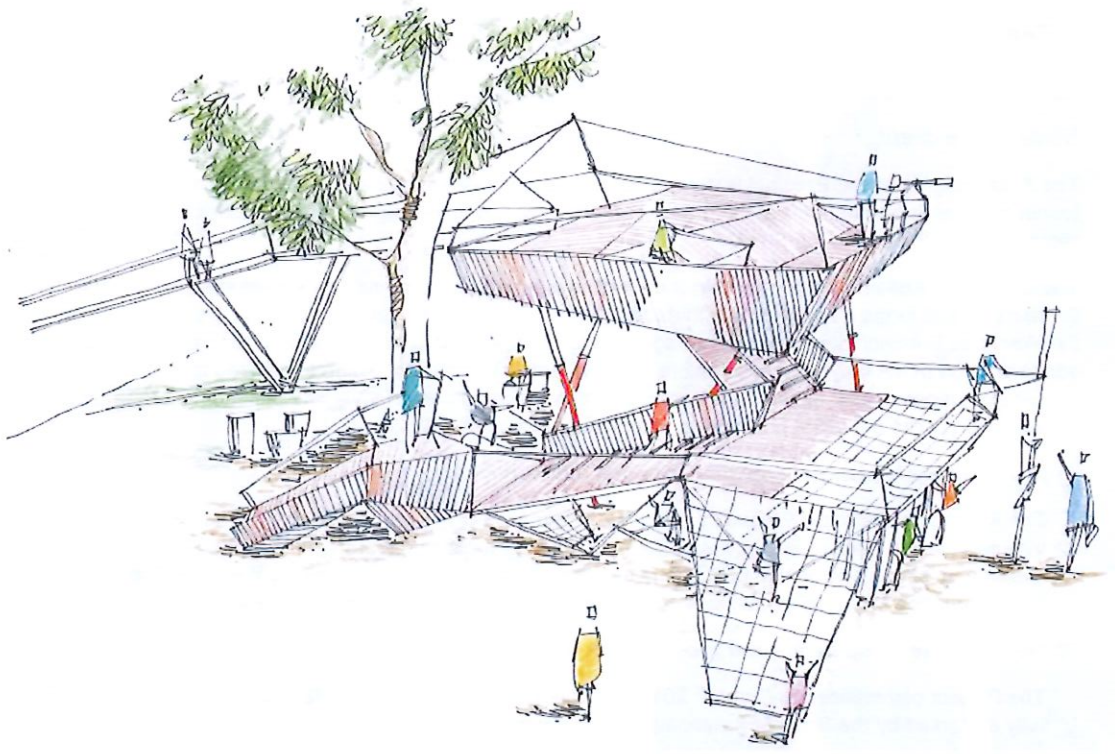
A) Provide details of supplying similar goods and services:

The Katanning Welcome Precinct project is a larger project in scale and budget, than the Wickepin Rest and Information Bay Masterplan, however both projects required an understanding of the regional context from material selection and design philosophy through to plant selection. Katanning Welcome Precinct also required the preparation of a landscape masterplan encompassing the project requirements.

B) Demonstrate competency and proven track record of achieving outcomes:

The Project commenced in October 2017 and was completed in March 2021, to programme. The project was fully endorsed by the Shire of Katanning and fully implemented.

RIO TINTO NATURESCAPE

Name of the project: Rio Tinto Naturescape Kings Park

Name of the client: Botanic Gardens and Parks Authority

PLAN E was engaged to prepare a Master Plan and implement an Environment based Play and Education Facility within Kings Park; a 6Ha nature-based landscape that inspires community learning and positive environmental interaction through fun, discovery, immersion and connection with nature in a safe, secure setting. The project was unique, requiring a highly nuanced approach to the project philosophy, design and implementation with a wide range of stakeholders including the community and government authorities. The project was complex but achieved on time and on budget

The project has won numerous industry awards and received international recognition for innovation in nature-based learning and play.

The Naturescape Kings Park project is a larger project in scale and budget, than the Wickepin Rest and Information Bay Masterplan, however both projects required an understanding of how people will use the space, in relation to the context in which it sits. Both projects require the preparation of a landscape masterplan to present an overall vision for the area.

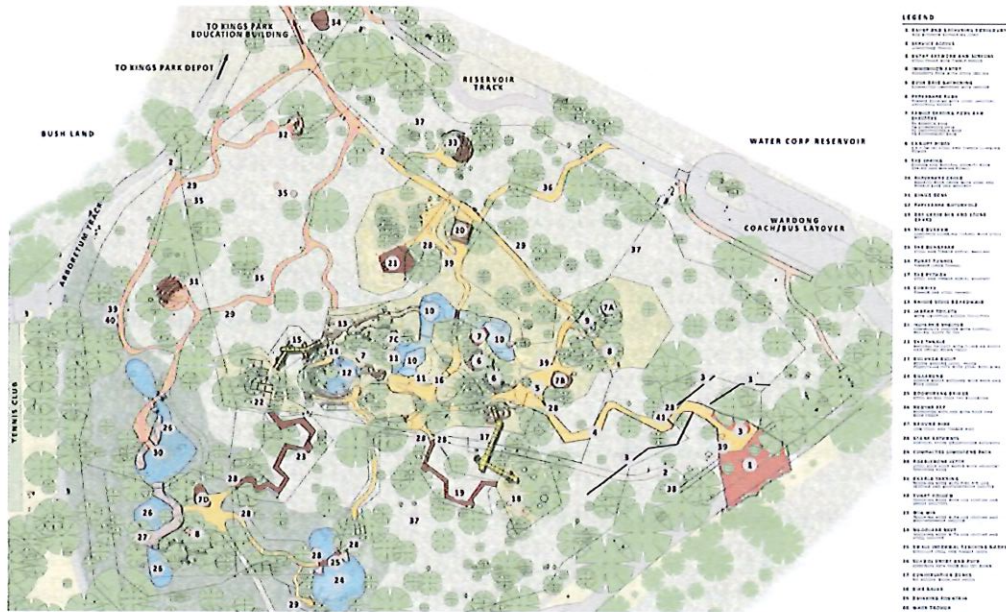
B) Demonstrate competency and proven track record of achieving outcomes:

Landscape Master Plan for Stages 1 & 2

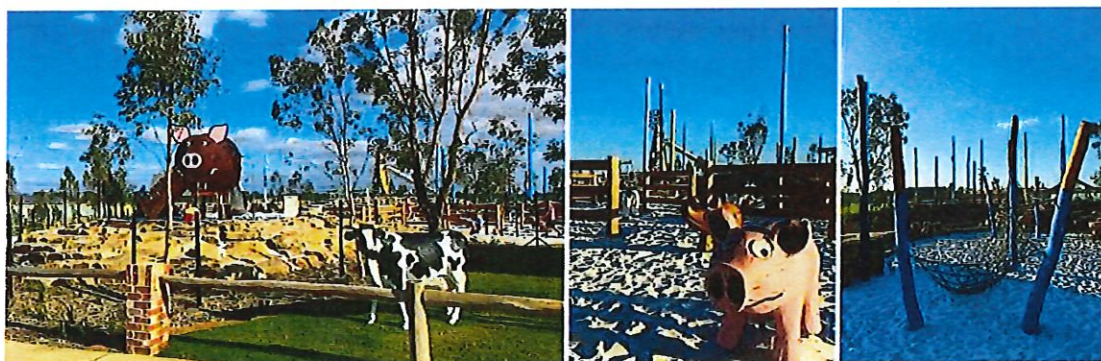
