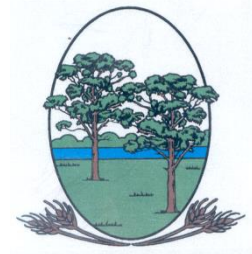

I have been asked to contact the shire regarding a few items which I will write below in dot point. These issues were discussed at our recent committee meeting.

1. CWA Building
  - a. Progress will be handing this building and all garden maintenance back to the shire. As of 1<sup>st</sup> April, Progress will no longer pay for the water or electricity.
