LAUNCH YEAR

ESTABLISHMENT PACKAGE

Price: \$8,800 (inc GST)

Our Launch package offers communities the ideal platform to establish their identity as an Astrotourism Town. It delivers comprehensive support to ensure capacity building and economic development for your community.

Assistance with the selection of two main locations in or near the Astrotourism Town:

- Observing Site (where visitors are welcome for stargazing activities and to use telescopes and binoculars)
- Astrophotography Hot Spot (a location with some visually interesting natural or built landscape where visitors are welcome to use cameras for astrophotography and/or stargazing activities)

No special infrastructure is required at either location. Public amenities such as ablutions, shelter and/or picnic facilities are welcomed by Astrotourists. However, these are not completely necessary. These locations are the places promoted to Astrotourists.

4. Free community stargazing event.

This event is designed to engage local community members and invite visitors to Astrotourism Towns. It includes a presentation

on Astrotourism, light pollution, why WA's regions are world-class destinations for Astrotourism activities, stargazing, viewing through telescopes, green laser pointer tour of the night sky to point out constellations and general Q&A. The event is engaging, easy to understand and entertaining. It also includes the design of a digital event poster.

5. Promotion of the Astrotourism Towns Network through:

- Australia's Golden Outback (AGO) and Australia's Coral Coast (ACC). Astrotourism WA is a Gold Member of each and places an advertisement in each of their annual holiday planners.
- working with tour operators to create itineraries on the Astrotourism WA network.
- WA amateur astronomy and astrophotography clubs and groups. Astrotourism WA is part of a local network of 6,000+ amateurs.



COMMUNITY STARGAZING EVENT | \$2,200 (inc GST)

This event can have a commercial focus with/without online ticket sales if desired. Communities are encouraged to keep this event free for locals and charge out-of-town visitors a fee. Revenue might be used to purchase a community telescope, recover costs or go towards a second event for the year. Includes promotion via Astrotourism WA website, social media, emailing lists

It includes two astronomy guides, an astronomy presentation, stargazing, viewing through telescopes, green laser pointer tour of the night sky to point out constellations and general Q&A. The event is engaging, easy to understand and entertaining.

- Digital event poster \$165 (inc GST)
- Social Media advertising for event \$220 (inc GST)
- Community event telescope prize for a local competition (Sky-Watcher 130mm table top Dobsonian Telescope) \$299 (inc GST)
- School incursion (2 hours) on light pollution, telescopes and astronomy (must be held on a school day afternoon prior to event held on the same day). This leads to an after-class activity to conduct a light audit for the Astrotourism Town. All instructions supplied. Students are encouraged to present light audit to Shire Council at one of its meetings \$385 (inc GST).



BUSINESS/PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT | \$3,300 (inc GST)

Build capacity and upskill identified local community members intending to or interested to develop an astronomy related tourism business or add an astronomy related service to an existing business. Includes 19 training/workshop with follow up advice and support.



ASTROPHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP | \$1,650 (inc GST)

An engaging and hands on practical workshop to upskill community members and/or to encourage visitors to town. This activity could be commercialised with online ticket sales through a local organisation. Includes promotion via Astrotourism WA website, social media and emailing lists. It includes one astrophotography guide and a practical astrophotography for beginners presentation with hands-on assistance for participants and their own cameras/tripods. This activity does not cover astrophotography through telescopes. Workshop time: approximately 3.5 hours. Maximum participant recommendation: 20 people.
