



Wickepin Centenary Wall

The Wickepin Centenary Wall was erected to allow past and present residents of the Wickepin District to be recognised for the time spent and the contributions made to the District.

The Centenary Wall was officially unveiled by Mr H. M. (Murray) Lang OAM, Freeman of the Wickepin Shire, on Saturday 25 October 2008.

In April 2024 the Centenary Wall was refurbished with new plaques by volunteers from the Wickepin History Group with financial assistance from the Shire of Wickepin.
