

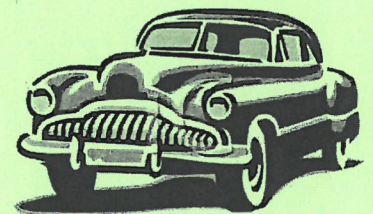
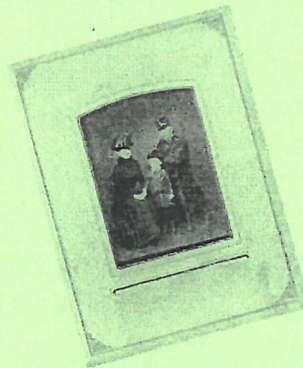
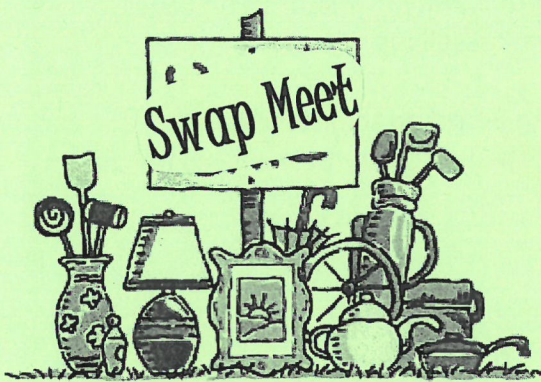

Congratulations to Matt and Helen Wyatt on the safe arrival of their baby boy, Eric James, on 19th August.

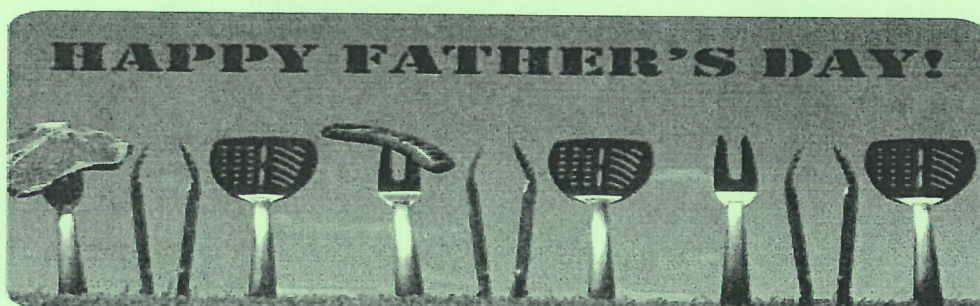


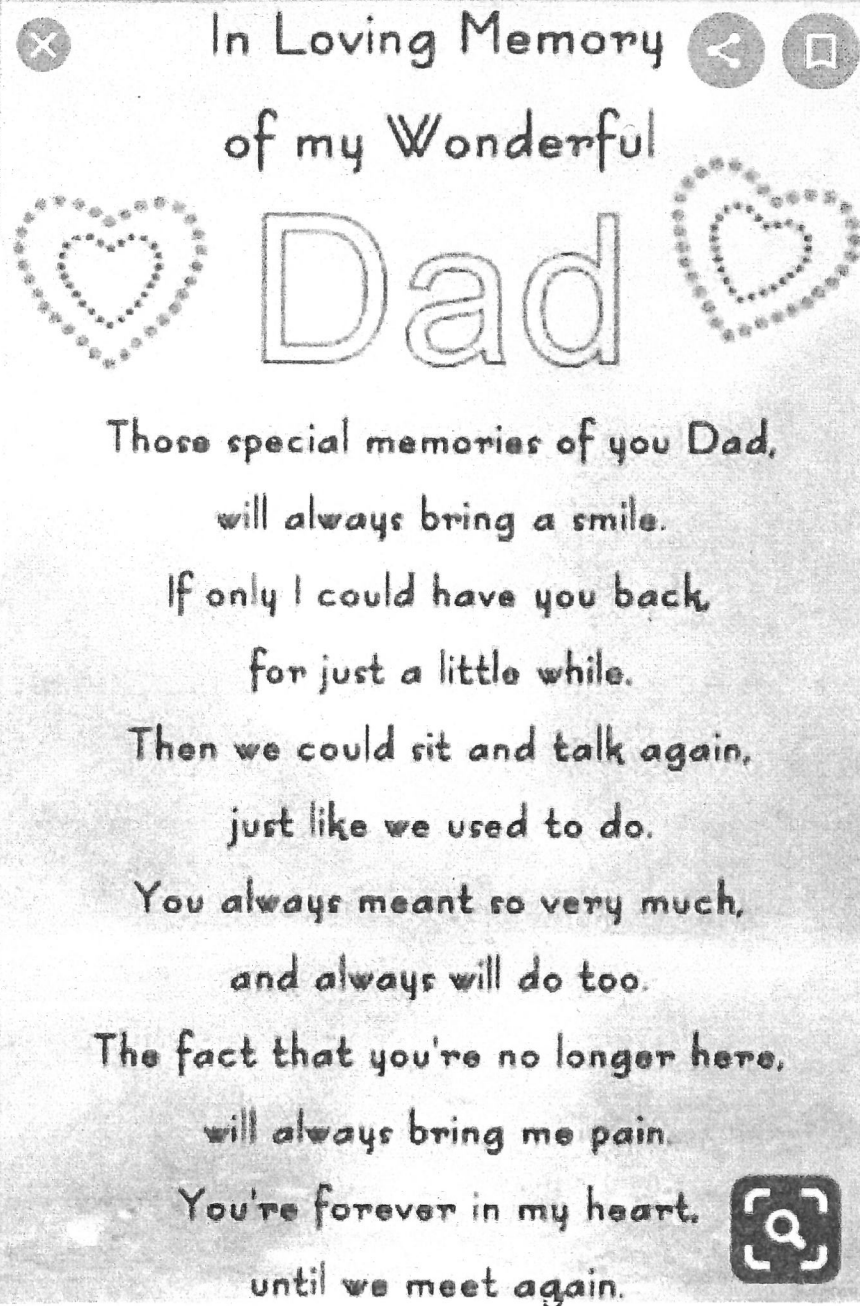

BUDGET 2020/21

Council at its budget meeting resolved to raise the same amount from rates as last year (2019/2020) which was \$1,481,372. Council has amended the rate in the dollar to allow for this, however due to an increase in valuations of 5.84% across the Shire by the Valuer General, some properties on unimproved values will have an increase due to these valuation changes.

WOGOLIN RD PLAYGROUND REDEVELOPMENT

Construction drawings and specifications, including the skate park, have been finalised and will be received by council by the end of August. Council will then begin the process of procuring quotes and preparing grant submissions.

INDEPENDENT LIVING UNITS

Council has signed the contract with KBuilt Constructions for the construction of four (4) 3 x 2 Independent Living Units in Johnston St, Wickepin.

WICKEPIN AQUATIC CENTRE

At the August ordinary meeting of council it was resolved that the Wickepin Aquatic Centre be closed every second Tuesday unless the temperature is above 35° C or there are VacSwim or Education Department swimming lessons.

CBH BIN ROAD

The CEO has entered into an agreement with CBH to undertake the road realignment works on Bin Road under the Planning Approval for the Wickepin Bin upgrades, this is in conjunction with the State Commodities route funding for Bin Road. It is anticipated that all sign offs with Main Roads will be completed soon which will allow the works on Bin Road to commence late August.

The Long Shadow - Anne Buist

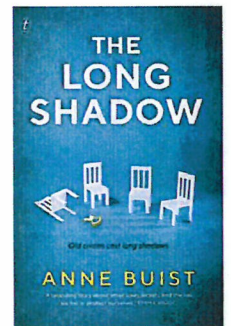

Then a series of small harassments begins.

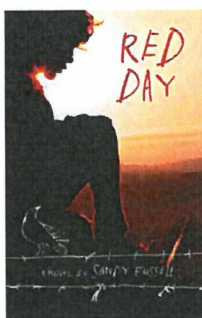
Is it an attempt to warn Dean off? Or could the threat be serious? A child was murdered in Riley once before.

Red Day - Sandy Fussell

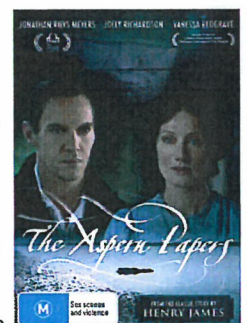

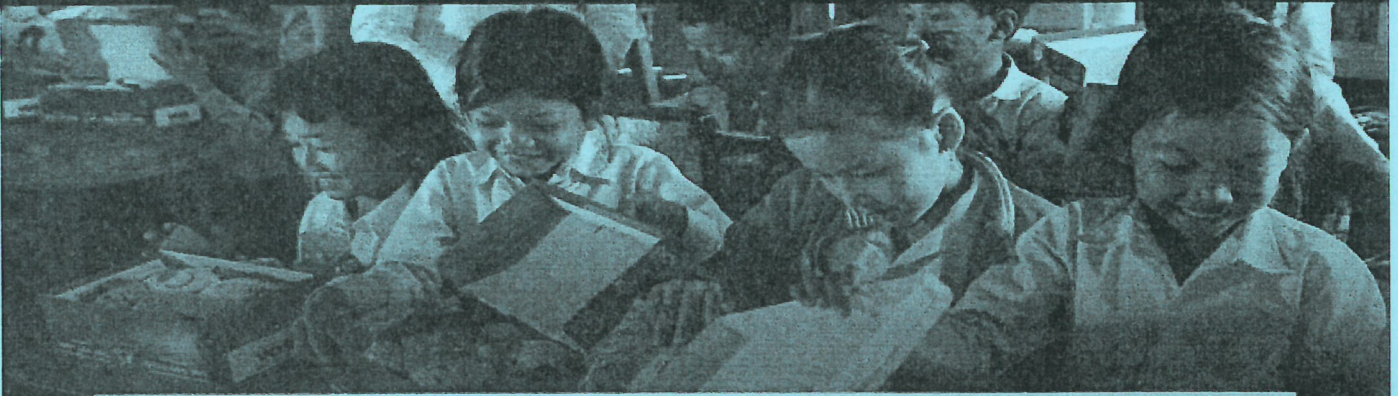

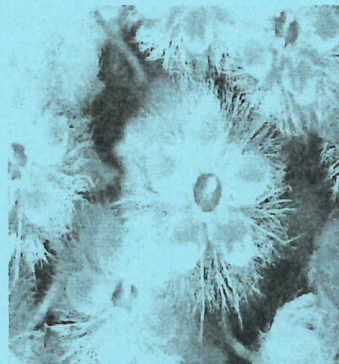

Bacon and Vegetable Soup



Ingredients:

- 2 teaspoons olive oil
- 1 leek, trimmed, halved, washed, thinly sliced
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 4 rashers middle bacon, chopped
- 1 celery stalk, trimmed, chopped
- 1 carrot, peeled, chopped
- 1 parsnip, peeled, chopped
- 1/3 cup pearl barley
- 400g can crushed tomatoes
- 6 cups chicken stock
- 1 medium zucchini, halved, sliced
- 1 medium potato, peeled, chopped

Method:

Heat oil in a large saucepan. Cook leek and garlic 2-3 minutes, add bacon, then add everything else. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 50 minutes until barley softens and the vegetables are tender.

Rogan Josh Lamb Meatballs

Ingredients:

- 500g lamb mince
- 1/4 cup rogan josh curry paste
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh coriander leaves
- 1/2 cup fresh breadcrumbs
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- 1 medium brown onion, halved, thinly sliced
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 400g can diced tomatoes
- 1/2 cup chicken style liquid stock
- 1/3 cup greek style yoghurt
- steamed basmati rice, to serve
- pappadums, to serve
- coriander leaves, to serve

Method:

Combine mince, paste, 2 tablespoons coriander, breadcrumbs and egg in a bowl. Season with pepper. Roll level tablespoons mixture into balls. Place on a plate. Cover with plastic wrap. Refrigerate for 20 minutes, if time permits.

Heat oil in a large frying pan over medium-high heat. Cook meatballs, turning, for 5 minutes or until browned. Transfer to a large plate. Cover to keep warm. Add onion and garlic to pan. Cook, stirring, for 5 minutes or until softened. Add tomato and stock. Bring to the boil. Return meatballs to pan. Reduce heat to low. Cook for 10 minutes or until meatballs are cooked through.

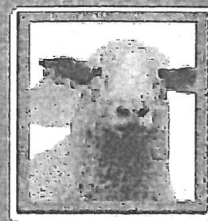
Combine yoghurt and remaining coriander in a bowl. Season with salt and pepper. Serve meatball mixture with rice, yoghurt mixture and pappadums.

The rink winners were Rex Bergin, Sam Horley (Narrogin) and Chris Moore. The play off winner was Sam Horley.

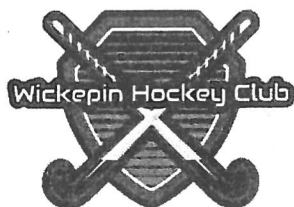
Sunday 23rd August
