
<u>Senior Citizens Homes - Survey</u> <u>Results 2012 / 2013</u>

The Shire of Wickepin recently sent out a survey regarding Senior Citizen Housing.

The response rate from the community was extremely good, and the results have been collated, analysed and sent off to the Wheatbelt Development Commission.

Council and the Lifestyle Retirement Committee would like to say thank you to all those that participated in the survey; your in-put will be used when decisions are made regarding the future development of aged care homes. We think it is extremely important that the community have their contribution to such major decisions with the Shire of Wickepin, especially when it is you who are effected.

The next process will be the Community Consultation—Wheatbelt Aged Care Plan which will be held on Tuesday 4 June 2013 at 2.30pm at the Wickepin Community Centre.





Community Consultation Wheatbelt Aged Care Plan

The Shire of Wickepin has committed \$5,000 to participate in a Regional Aged Care Planning process to develop and assist in the implementation of an Integrated Wheatbelt Aged Care Plan, with the Wheatbelt Development Commission.

The Plan will build on our existing services and infrastructure while finding methods in which our residents can age in their homes and communities for longer.

Funded through a partnership between the Wheatbelt Development Commission, the WA Country Health Service's Southern Inland Health Initiative (SIHI), and Local Government, the Wheatbelt Integrated Aged Support and Care Solution/s (WIASCS) is a proactive process which will produce Shire specific Needs Studies and an overall Wheatbelt Integrated Regional Aged Care Plan.

The Plan will look at all facets of Aged Care from Aged Friendly Communities, Aged Persons Housing, Community Care and Residential Care.

Melbourne Consultants Verso have been appointed to carry out this work and have prepared a summary of aged housing and care needs for our Shire. Verso would like to present these findings to the community to receive our thoughts and inputs, this will also provide a more accurate account of what will work and what is important to our community.

This is an invitation to all community members who access Aged Care services or have experienced the delivery of Aged Care services in our community to attend.

The community consultation will be held on Tuesday 4 June 2013 at 2.30pm at the Wickepin Community Centre.
