



#### BUSH FIRE SEASON 2017/2018

Council would like to remind residents of the Shire of Wickepin that they are required on or before 1 October 2017 and thereafter to 14 April 2018 to plough, scarify or otherwise provide and maintain firebreaks clear of all inflammable material at least 2.5 metres wide as follows:

#### **Rural Land**

Inside the boundary of all land held by each owner or occupier, their firebreaks need not follow the perimeter of any paddock but will be acceptable following land contours in an endeavour to overcome water erosion;

- To subdivide each holding into lots of no greater than 200 hectares; and
- To surround the homestead, out buildings and fuel storages on any such land.

#### **Townsite Land**

All lots within the townsites of Harrismith, Tincurrin, Toolibin, Wickepin and Yealering are required to be cleared and maintained free of all debris or inflammable material. Failure to comply with these réquirements renders the owner or occupier liable to a penalty not more than \$400.

The Bush Fire Control Officers would like to advise that due to the expected weed growth, all fire breaks will be inspected and there will be no tolerance toward poor fire breaks.

If you abandon your damaged vehicle and do not tell us, we do not know what has happened, which leads us to become concerned for the welfare of the occupants. We then have to conduct a search of the area and use police resources to try and track down the user of the vehicle(s) to make sure they are okay.

Also if you witness a crash or if you notice a vehicle that looks to have been involved in a crash by the side of the road, please give us a call. Try and obtain as much information as possible like the location, registration and if there is anyone in the vehicle and their condition. However if you see one of these A4 sized orange stickers anywhere on the vehicle it means that police are already aware.







# Christmas Cookery

# Fruit Cake

Ingredients

3 cups sultanas

11/2 cups raisins

1 cup currants

1 cup pitted dates, finely chopped

1x100g pkt red glace cherries

75g craisins

75g dried pineapple, finely chopped

4 cup mixed peel

34 cup brandy



2 teaspoons finely grated orange rind
Melted butter to grease
250g butter, room temperature
1 cup brown sugar
4 eggs
2 cups plain flour
2 teaspoons mixed spice
Decorate with blanched almonds, red glace cherries, halved, and two extra tablespoons of

#### Method

Combine sultanas, raisins, currants, dates cherries, craisins, pineapple, mixed peel, brandy & orange rind in a large bowl. Cover with plastic and set aside stirring occasionally, for 2 days.

brandy

Preheat oven to 150°c. Brush a round 22cm cake tin with melted butter to lightly grease. Line the base & side with 3 layers of non–stick baking paper.

Beat butter & sugar until pale & creamy. Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating well between each addition.

Add butter mixture to fruit mixture & stir to combine.

Add flour & mixed spice, stir until well combined. Spoon into prepared pan & smooth the surface, then tap the pan on a benchtop to release air bubbles.

Arrange almonds & cherries on top of cake. Bake in oven covered with foil for  $2^{1/2}$  to 3 hours or until skewer inserted into centre comes out clean.

Drizzle hot cake with extra brandy. Set aside to cool before turning out.

Cover with plastic wrap and store in an air-tight container in a cool dark place.

# ShortBread

250g butter at room temperature

1 cup icing sugar

2 1/4 cups plain flour

1/4 cup cornflour

1 eggwhite, lightly beaten

2 tablespoons white sugar

### Method

Preheat oven to 160°c

# IN THE KITCHEN



Beat butter, icing sugar and vanilla until pale & creamy. Sift flour & cornflour over butter mixture. Stir until a soft dough forms. Turn onto on lightly floured surface. Knead dough until smooth. Divide dough in half, & place onto baking trays lined with baking paper marked with circles as a guide. Press shortbread out with fingers to form a 1.5cm thick, 18cm diameter round. Pinch the edges to form a frill. Score 8 triangles in each shortbread. Refrigerate for 15 minutes until firm. Brush shortbread with eggwhite & sprinkle with sugar. Bake 30 to 35 minutes until shortbread is light golden and firm to touch. Allow to cool completely on trays.



# **History Snippet**


Taken from Wickepin Football Club Centenary 1910-2010

# May 20 1939 Wickepin v Pingelly

Bob Duncan, kicking 4 goals, was more than a match winner for his side. Toby Miller dished up some fine football both in defence and in the forward line. His high marking and long kicking were features of his play. Jack Pauley, a whippy wing man, played well to the advantage of his side, being in position and a good disposal of the ball. Dick Hoyle, the giant of the team, battled hard in ruck, using his height when necessary. 'Rip' McMahon, although not up to his usual standard, played some heady football. 'Pip' McAuliffe filled his position admirably, keeping his man very quiet and doing fine work in the back line. Skipper Lee, not up to his old form, pulled his weight by his good captaincy. # WHO SAYS MEN DON'T REMEMBER?


A couple were Christmas shopping. The shopping centre was packed and as the wife walked around, she was surprised to discover that her husband was no-where to be seen.


