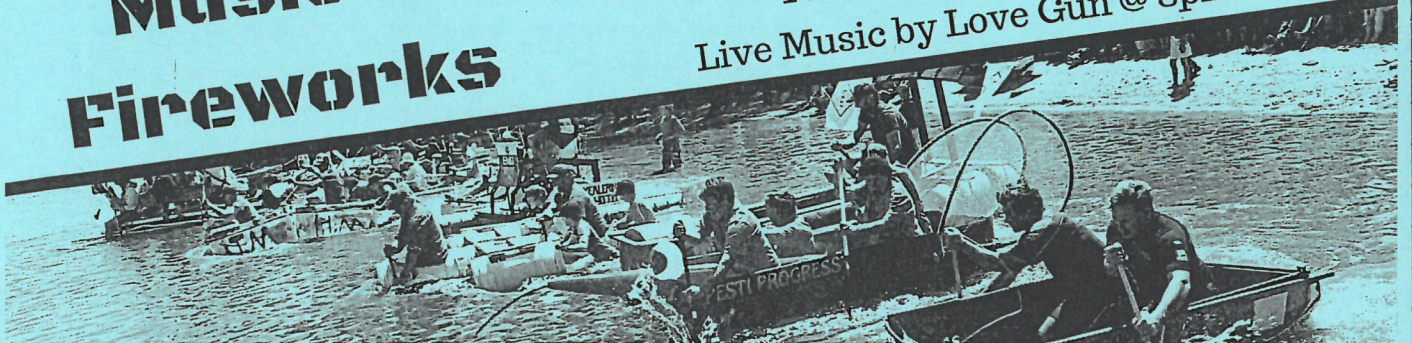

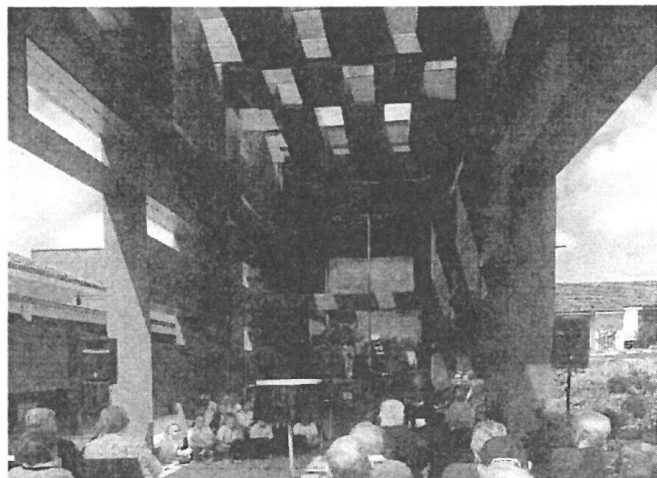
Member for Agriculture region Darren West officially opened the building much to the delight of all. A well catered for afternoon tea was served followed by tours conducted by staff.

### Changes to the Scheme

- The 'first and last mile' special RAV access arrangements have been finalised
- HMMS will continue, however will revert to its original intent as a mass management scheme

### Access Update


- 1053 roads were endorsed under HMMS Road Lists for the 2018-19 harvest period
- Onsite assessments are underway with the intent to add these endorsed roads to the relevant RAV Networks prior to the upcoming harvest period
- This eliminates the need for future special access arrangements under HMMS

### Key Points

- No changes to the HMMS mass provisions
- Apply for new RAV access early, allowing up to 12 weeks
- HMMS access is now via RAV Networks or Restricted Local Access Permits

## Harvest Mass Management Scheme

### What you need to know for 2019-2020 Harvest Period


### Register for HMMS

- If you wish to participate in HMMS, continue to register your vehicles with a participating Grain Receiver
- Familiarise yourself with the HMMS Business Rules, available on the Harvest Mass Management Scheme page of our website
- DO NOT submit a HMMS Road List to Main Roads

### New RAV Access

- If there are additional roads you need for an upcoming harvest period, which are not approved for RAV access and you did not apply for them under HMMS last season, you will need to apply to Main Roads to have the roads assessed via the standard RAV application process

### RAV Access Options

- Use a Category 1 RAV vehicle combination that is 20 m or less in length and 50 t or less in gross mass on any road
- Use a RAV that is greater than a Category 1 RAV vehicle combination on approved RAV Network roads

## WOGOLIN PLAYGROUND CONCEPT PLAN – UPDATE ON COMMUNITY SURVEY AND FEEDBACK

A big shout out to everyone who responded to our request for feedback / comments on the current concept plan for a playground / recreation area situated on the main street of Wickepin. Consulting with our community is an integral part of building better amenities which serve the needs of those who live here.

The survey has now closed and the results have been collated with a total of 33 responses via our FB Survey (28) and feedback forms (5). In summary, 30 have seen the plan / 3 had not, 24 support the current plan / 3 don't / 3 selected other, 33 agreed that a nature based park is a good idea and 29 local families indicated that they would use the park and 4 said they would not.

Some of the suggestions and comments included:-More Shade, undercover areas, equipment to cater to toddlers, road safety - including fencing and zebra crossing, more seating, water feature, drinking fountains, special needs equipment, bird attracting plants local to the area, climbing equipment, locating playground in a different site, BBQ area, lighting and tie up rails for animals.

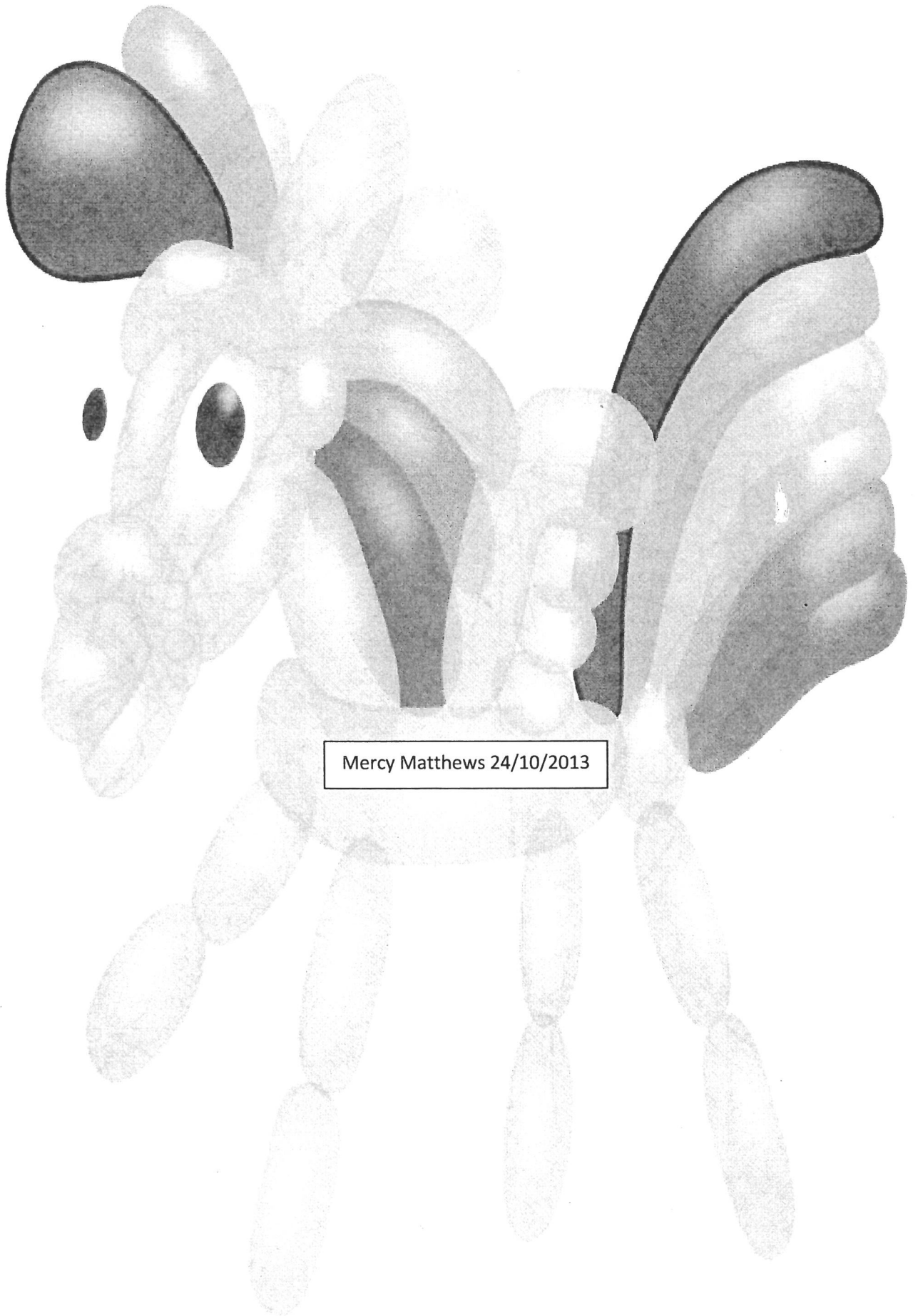

# IN THE KITCHEN

## Chicken and tarragon pies

Serves 4

- 1 bunch bulb spring onions
- 1 tablespoon margarine
- 250g button mushrooms, sliced
- 750g chicken breast fillets, trimmed, chopped into 3cm pieces
- 1 cup reduced-salt chicken stock
- ¼ cup tarragon leaves, roughly chopped
- 2 tablespoons cornflour
- 4 sheets frozen ready-rolled reduced-fat puff pastry, partially thawed
- olive oil cooking spray

- 1 Preheat oven to 200°C. Grease four 1¾-cup capacity ramekins or pudding basins. Trim and quarter onions, leaving 1cm of green stalk at top.
- 2 Melt margarine in a large, deep frying pan over medium heat. Add onion and cook for 3 minutes. Add mushrooms and cook for 5 minutes or until juice evaporates. Add chicken and cook for 5 minutes or until browned.
- 3 Add stock and tarragon. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 3 minutes. Combine cornflour and 2 tablespoons water. Pour into pan in a steady stream, stirring constantly to

prevent lumps from forming. Simmer for 2 minutes or until thick. Season with salt and pepper. Set aside to cool completely.

4 Using the top of dish as a guide, cut a disc 2cm wider than the dish (all the way round) from each sheet. Spoon filling into ramekins. Top with pastry rounds, pressing edges to seal. Spray with oil. Sprinkle with salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper. Cut a small cross in pie tops. Bake for 30 to 35 minutes or until pastry is light golden and puffed.

## Tasty Lime Curd Pies

Makes 6

- 1 eggwhite
- ¼ cup caster sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 teaspoons cornflour
- 1 cup desiccated coconut
- ½ cup thickened cream, whipped
- 3 egg yolks
- ¼ cup caster sugar
- 50g butter, chopped
- 2 large limes, rind finely grated, juiced

- 1 Make lime curd Place egg yolks, sugar, butter, lime rind and ¼ cup lime juice in a heatproof bowl. Stand over a saucepan of simmering water, making sure bowl doesn't touch water. Stir mixture with a wooden spoon for 10 minutes or until thickened. Cover with plastic wrap. Allow to cool. Refrigerate until cold.
- 2 Preheat oven to 160°C. Brush four 8cm-base loose-based flan pans with oil. Line with rounds of baking paper.
- 3 Using an electric mixer, beat eggwhite until soft peaks form. Gradually add sugar, beating constantly until sugar

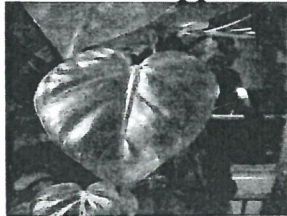
dissolves and mixture is thick and glossy.

4 Fold in vanilla, cornflour and coconut. Divide mixture evenly between pans. Using wet fingertips, press to cover base and sides (not quite to top of pans). Bake tart cases for 10 to 12 minutes or until light golden. Stand for 5 minutes. While still warm, loosen tart cases from sides of pans but do not remove (if too cool, they may stick to sides and be hard to remove later on). Stand on a wire rack to cool.

5 Remove tart cases from pans. Spoon lime curd evenly into cases. Top with cream and serve.







## *Indoor Plant Care...*



*Spring is Here!! And is the perfect time to give your Indoor Plants a bit of T.L.C. after they have struggled through Winter's low light levels, reduced humidity and cooler temperatures. Here we go through a few easy tasks to get your Indoor Beauties looking at their best.*

**Repotting:** After a couple of years of your plants being in the same pot, the potting mix becomes significantly degraded with compaction, acidification and nutrient loss. Pull your plants out of their pots, knock out some of the old potting mix from the root balls and replant using a premium potting mix. (Now is also a great time to divide your plant, or replant into a bigger pot, if it has outgrown it's original pot.) Water in with some seaweed solution to help the plant settle back in quickly.

**Prune & Tidy:** Encourage new growth by pruning any dead or yellowing foliage and untidy endings. This allows more light into the centre of the plant and also just "makes it look better".

**Dusting:** Indoor plants get covered in the same dust as our furniture does, which reduces their ability to photosynthesise, which in turn inhibits growth and vitality. Take your plants outside and give them a "hose off" (gently of course), or put them in the shower for a few minutes, or wipe the leaves with a clean, damp cloth. They will be able to breath easier, and will love you for their fresh wash.

**Pest Inspection:** Scale and Mites - just two of the most common pests that can make our indoor plants feel unwell and look rather pale, drawn and sad, but are usually easily controlled with an oil spray.

**Feeding:** With new warmth and light conditions, together with a wash and tidy up, your indoor plants will be invigorated to put on a growth spurt. As such, they will benefit from being fed, and will respond well to regular doses of liquid fertiliser (applied at the recommended rates on the packets).

**New Positions:** Sometimes our homes do not give as much regular bright light as is necessary for indoor plants to really thrive, so a change of scenery may be just what is needed. Rotate your plants around the house so that they enjoy different light positions, or place them outside in a sheltered spot for a bit of "refreshment" for a few weeks every couple of months.
